## Diplomates can also Nominate Candidates to the Board

To be eligible for nomination:

- Diplomates must be in good standing with the ABOI/ID,
- be a Fellow or Associate Fellow of the AAID, and
- not also be an officer or member of the Board of any other oral implant organization or of any other dental or medical specialty board.
- Consistent with the *Bylaws*, all nominations <u>must be received</u> in ABOI/ID office by 5:00 p.m. Central Time, Thursday, September 3, 2009.
- The election will take place on Tuesday, November 3, 2009 by mail ballot if an additional candidate is nominated.
- If no other candidate is nominated, the ABOI/ID Board will vote on the candidate Thursday, November 5, 2009.
